WHAT IS AUBURN UNIVERSITY DANCE MARATHON?

Auburn University Dance Marathon (AUDM) first joined Children's Miracle Network Hospitals in 2011 in a partnership to support Columbus Regional Medical Center. In their first year, the AUDM staff was able to raise \$65,995.25 for the families. In their second year the staff increased the final amount and raised \$124,739.89. Finally, this past year, AUDM staff's hard work brought in \$176,589.65. Each year culminates with a 12 hour-long event where Auburn students stay on their feet through dancing, games, and entertainment in order to celebrate the total amount raised that year. Miracle families come speak at the event and dance along with students.

THE CAUSE



Children's Miracle Network Hospitals is a non-profit organization that raises funds for more than 170 Children's hospitals. They treat over 17 million patients per year from a variety of different health backgrounds. In all, the Children's Miracle Network Hospitals provide over \$2.5 billion dollars in uncompensated health care each year. Auburn Dance Marathon specifically works with the Midtown Medical Center at Columbus Regional Health to provide funds to help grow their NICU as well as their growing PICU. In the past years, the funds raised went to help them purchase the new neonatal transport system.

FACULTY INVOLVEMENT

This year, as we try and grow the presence of Dance Marathon on Auburn's campus, we are really hoping to get the alumni involved! Some examples of ways to get involved include:
